

A stamp shop owner in New Zealand

„A stamp shop owner in New Zealand has collected paquebot marks for some 40 years and certainly since 2000 has endeavoured to keep the subject going when all around was quietly diminishing, however for the purpose of this book and/or Addenda his efforts have to be seen within the parameters of the subject of paquebot marks and how we place them in the book itself. The layout below will help the collector to distinguish between what is actually a post office used mark and what is just an addition to a cover.“

Mike Dovey writes this in his book „Paquebot Cancellations of the World - The 2020 ADDENDA“ on page 71 and then shows a series of stamp images that can be assigned to this shop owner.

The two covers shown here, kindly provided by the German collector Dirk Stratmann, are not illustrated by M. Dovey in his ADDENDA, but can also be attributed to the activities of the New Zealand collector.

The privately manufactured paquebot stamp has the following dimensions 20,5 x 4 mm and was not applied by the post office in Lyttelton.

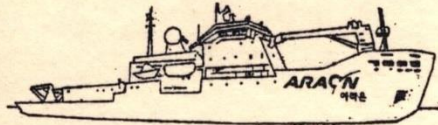
